on the day, month and year as stated bellow in accordance with the Czech Civil Code No. 89/ 2012 Coll. and Commercial Law No. 90/2012 Coll., as amended, under the following provisions.

Preamble

1. In accordance with their mutual interest, the Contracting Parties express herewith their willingness and will to provide an MBA or DBA study programme on one side and study on the other side.

Article I.

Subject of the contract

1. CBU commits itself to provide the Student with education at, Master of Business Administration (MBA) level or Doctor of Business Administration (DBA) level in the agreed below stated specialization in terms that are line with the CBU's study plan, allow the student to study and in case of successful passing through the educational programme, provide him or her with MBA, DBA, MHA title stated below, written behind the name without a dot and provide him or her with a diploma and diploma supplement that includes a transcript. The Student agrees to follow the provisions of the contract, and pay CBU the tuition price that has been agreed.

Article II.
Rights and obligations of participants

1. CBU ensures its Students the proper conditions to promote personal development within their field of study and recognizes students' rights of participation, free expression and cultural autonomy.
2. The CBU's educational objective is to transmit knowledge and information for personal and professional growth, integrating the Students' experience to the dynamic working environment.
3. CBU Students have recognized rights without distinction of sex, religion, political opinion or personal and social conditions.

Article III.
Tuition fee

1. Student is obliged to pay CBU or an organization set by CBU the tuition fee specified in the amendment No. 1 of this contract.
2. All amendments of this contract are private and not be disclosed to third parties. Violation would be subject to payment of the sum of 5000 CZK to the other party of this contract.
3. The two parties may agree on other means of payment (Cash, Credit Card, etc.) as well.
4. The tuition may be paid by a third party (e.g. an employer).
5. Should the Student ignore study obligations for any reason(s), it does not constitute the right to request any refund(s) and does not impact student's obligation to pay the tuition fee.
6. Should the Student be late in payment for any reason and CBU does not have any agreement or guarantees that it will be done so in the future, it grants the CBU the right (not obligation) to unilaterally cancel the provision of education to the Student. This, on the other hand, does not free the student from the obligation to pay the tuition fee.
7. If the Student does not sign this contract within the period of 30 days, the CBU reserves the right to update the tuition price in respect to current tuition fees.
8. If the student is late with any kind of payment past the agreed schedule, interest in line with law may be charged.

Article IV.
Ending of a study programme

1. Study ends with successful fulfillment of all study requirements.
2. Premature ending of the study programme is possible using a written agreement about withdrawal from the contract between the Student and CBU or unilaterally by CBU due to student's failing to accomplish study obligations. In such a case the student has to pay full tuition fee by the last day of agreed end of study. Tuition fee may be set individually based on written agreement.
3. Student has the right to unilaterally end the study during the course of the study programme, without providing a reason. This, on the other hand, does not free the Student from the obligation to pay the tuition fee by the last day of the study.

Article V.
Final provisions

1. This contract is governed by Czech law, especially the Czech Civil Code No. 89/ 2012 Coll. and Commercial Law No. 90/2012 Coll., and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Czech courts.
2. CBU reserves the right to not opening an MBA or DBA study programme due to insufficient number of candidates or other important reason. In this case, the Student has the right to apply for nearest possible programme that will be opened but with discount, may ask for refund of the tuition paid, as he or she would withdraw from the contract. In that case CBU is obliged to return the full tuition paid within 15 days since the written request to withdraw from the contract is received by the CBU. Should the programme be canceled, the CBU will inform the Student when it finds out about it.
3. Liability of CBU, and/or its partners providing MBA or DBA programme, for losses arising from their negligence (except in the case of liability for death or personal injury), breach of contract or otherwise will be limited to the full amounts paid by the relevant student for the particular

educational clusters and/or study materials. Except in the case of liability for death and personal injury, such companies will have no liability for indirect or consequential loss or damage howsoever arising.

4. This contract may be modified or amended only in writing.
5. Student confirms that he or she has read this contract, understands it, agrees with all provisions contained and when signing it expresses his or her free will.
6. By signing the contract the Student enrolls as a student of the CBU.
7. Student confirms that he or she read the MBA or DBA programme description on internet pages of CBU www.cbuni.cz and understood it.
8. Student agrees, in line with Czech law on private data protection No. 101/2000 Coll. as amended, with processing of his or her personal data only for purposes related to MBA or DBA programme study and other services provided by the CBU during the course of the MBA or DBA study programme and after it ends and not distributing these data elsewhere for any purposes anytime in the future. This agreement is granted since Application submission till it is revoked even if the Student does not enroll as a Student (signs this contract).
9. The CBU sends out important student information (including timetable updates, class changes, etc.) exclusively by email. The Student agrees that it is his or her sole responsibility to keep the contact information up-to-date so that the CBU has correct email addresses, and that the Student opens, reads and acts promptly upon such email notifications. Any updates need to be sent anytime to info@cbuni.cz.
10. The Terms and Conditions are integral part of this contract.
